Your process paper includes a title page, your answering of the four questions (see preliminary process paper form) and an annotated bibliography, all bound with ONE staple. The title page includes only your project title, your name(s), and your grade. With each source citation in your bibliography, include a two to three sentence description of what material you found in the source or how you used the source in your final project.

Each homeroom will have a list of where/when your project will be judged. Each exhibit should be fully assembled and displayed before homeroom and exhibit judging will start at or before 9:00 am. Performances/videos will be scheduled in advance and each presenter must be 15 minutes early of their scheduled time. Those who are scored by judges as winners will be:

- 1) asked to continue in the competition to compete against other schools.
- 2) asked to keep their projects here at school for display purposes.

If you are not selected as a winner by the judges, you must have your project taken home by the end of the day. Failure to have your project taken home will be reflected in your Social Studies research project grade.
